Quick-Start & Care Guide

It ships already activated — there's nothing to set up. Just hide it in your vehicle.

Hide It Well

Pick a spot that's out of sight and secure.

GOOD SPOTS:

- Under or behind a seat
- Trunk liner
- Under the rear cargo mat
- Behind interior trim

AVOID:

- Glove box
- Center console
- Door pockets
- Cupholders



You'll know your device by the gray CarSmarti steering-wheel emblem on top.

If It Beeps, Relax

A short beep is normal — the chip is just "waking up." It is not a malfunction.



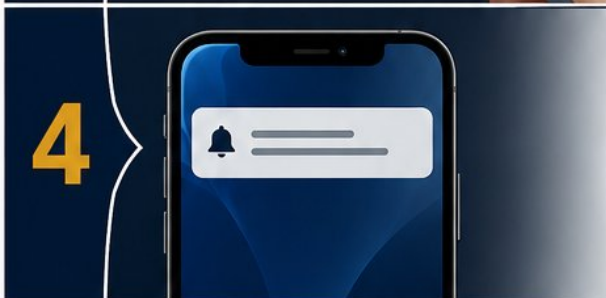

Don't Reset It or Change the Battery

Resetting it or changing the battery unlinks it from our recovery network — permanently.

A replacement device is then required (billable).

The battery lasts about a year, and we replace the unit for you each year.

Phone Alerts Are Expected

Your phone, or a passenger's, may show:

- iPhone — "[Item] Found Moving With You" or "Unknown Accessory Detected."
- Android — "Tracker traveling with you."

It's just your phone noticing the chip in your own vehicle.

Dismiss it — but never use the option to disable the device.

If Your Vehicle Is Stolen

- 1 Call 1-888-992-6659
- 2 File a police report
- 3 We coordinate the chip's location directly with law enforcement until you're reunited.
